



POOL ACCESS REGULATIONS

Art. 1 - Persons attending the swimming pool must read these regulations and, in any case, may not plead ignorance of them.

Art. 2 - The service staff is authorized to intervene to enforce these regulations and may expel any transgressors.

Art. 3 - Attendees must keep to the opening and closing times, during closing breaks and in any case in the absence of a bathing attendant it is strictly forbidden to enter the pool.

Art. 4 - It is advisable to allow a minimum interval of 3 hours between meals and swimming.

Art. 5 - It is compulsory to shower before entering the pool

Art. 6 - It is forbidden for people to enter the pool if they are in an altered psycho-physical state (drunkenness, impaired by drugs, etc.) or even in an obvious precarious state of health, such as to pose a risk to the safety of others and of the person himself.

Art. 7 - It is forbidden to smoke in the changing rooms or to consume food or drink.

Art. 8 - No glass of any kind or sharp objects may be brought into the pool.

Art. 9 - The Direction reserves the right, also through the service staff present, to refuse entry to the pool and to revoke the stay of anyone who disturbs good order or the smooth running of the service, or causes offence to decorum and morals.

Art. 10 - It is forbidden to circulate, stay or enter the pool without a swimming suit.

Art. 11 - It is forbidden to soil the water in the pools in any way or to introduce personal objects into them.

Art. 12 - It is forbidden to bring dogs or other animals onto the pool deck.

Art. 13 - Persons suffering from infectious diseases, skin lesions or open wounds, even if protected by medication, may not enter the pool.

Art. 14 - The management, through the staff present on the pool deck, reserves the right to remove anyone who disturbs with inappropriate behavior and/or attitudes.

Art. 15 - In order to avoid infections, it is forbidden to circulate in the pool area wearing footwear that is not footwear or rubber slippers reserved for this use only.

Art. 16 - According to the law, showering without a swimming costume is forbidden.

Art. 17 - Dinghies, life jackets, masks, flippers, diving weights, balls or anything else that may be considered dangerous to pool-goers are not allowed in the pool.

Art. 18 - Pushing, diving and jumping into the water from the sides of the pools is forbidden, except for those envisaged by the swimming courses and under the supervision of the instructors. To avoid danger to oneself and others, running in the immediate vicinity of the pools is forbidden.

Art. 19 - Playing is forbidden if it disturbs guests.

Art. 20 - apnea is not allowed.

Art. 21 - It is forbidden for children under 12 to enter free swimming activities unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Art. 22 - Leave the changing rooms tidy.

Art. 23 - Leave the toilets in a hygienic condition after use.

The accompanying persons will in any case be held responsible for any damage to property or persons caused by minors.
